

Waverly – Shell Rock Soccer Complex Use 2006

2006 was the third full year of operation. The Complex opened in the fall of 2003.

High school practices started about March 13, 2006. Fall youth season ended October 29 (although some teams still practiced the following week for away games.)

There were 581 games played at our Complex (youth, high school and college), up from 318 games in 2005. We hosted teams and fans from all of the CVYSA communities, plus Ames, Cedar Rapids, Iowa City, Newton, Webster City, Dubuque, Mason City, Urbandale, Johnston, Glenwood, Colfax-Mingo, Bettendorf, Muscatine, North Park College in Chicago, Macalester College in St. Paul, Minnesota, Central College, and Wartburg College. We hosted high school substate playoffs for both boys and girls, as well as high school tournaments for both boys and girls. We hosted 276 youth players for our Spring clinic in cooperation with Wartburg College, and the summer Eurotech soccer camp again visited our complex. The City of Waverly held youth clinics for 46 players. We have seen a significant increase in the number of players, young and old, came out to play and practice on their own, especially during the evening in the summer. We held our first club tournament, the Jack-O'-Lantern Jamboree, the Saturday before Halloween. In 2007 we will host the Kohl's American Cup, which is the state recreational tournament, a two-day event, on September 8 and 9, and we will again host the Jack-O'-Lantern Jamboree on Halloween weekend.

Fall Total Games: 281

For recreational youth soccer, we have a six week spring season and a six week fall season for games, and most teams practice about 8 weeks each season total. Travel team youth soccer has a season of 8 to 10 weeks, spring and fall, and teams practice about 12 weeks per season, and some practice during the summer.

Estimated 28 players played in the 518 games, and they brought average of 3 people with them per player, for a total game attendance of about 58,000 people for the year.

Estimated 240 hours of high school practices, or 20,640 contact hours for high school practices.

Major work done at the Complex in 2006 included repairing the water damage to the parking lots, acquiring one set of team benches, raising irrigation sprinkler heads, work on the sidewalk inside the premier field, and re-sodding the goal areas in several fields. Work remaining to be done includes fencing along 8th Street, finishing the sidewalk inside the premier field, portable bleacher and team seating and some signage.
